

Confirmation Class Information (Levels I, II,) 2015-2016

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ** Teachers:** Level I/Grade 7 & Level 2/Grade 8 Combined
David Lintvedt & Dawn Harris
- ** Class Attendance:** We need to see you on dates/classes you are signed up for.
- ** Church Attendance:** We expect to see you in church at least twice per month.
- ** First Communion:** First Communion will generally occur the same Sunday as Confirmation, in the 8th grade year. Youth will receive First Communion and Confirmation on the SAME DAY. Unusual circumstances will be dealt with on an individual basis.
- ** Requirement Review:** A “Requirement Standings” sheet will be provided to the parent/guardian (1) time during the year (January). This will show you where your youth stands with regard to the requirements.
- ** Pre/Post Test:** A pre-test (beginning of year) and post-test (end of year) may be administered to guide instruction and demonstrate the importance of consistent attendance. NOT a factor in getting confirmed; however, attendance is a factor (see above guidelines).

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

All Confirmation students are expected to fulfill the minimum requirements as listed.

I. Sermon Reviews:

Complete at least (18)

(1/2) by Mid-December, and the remaining (1/2) May.

II. Bear Creek Camp Retreat:

November 13-15, 2015 All Confirmation Youth are **required** to attend. If unable to attend, students **must** complete an alternate project following the retreat.

III. Upper Perkiomen Manor (October) OR Shelter Trip (November):

Youth are expected to participate in at least one.

IV. Church Holiday Programs:

Be an active participant

a. Christian Education Christmas Program, 12/20/15

b. Christian Education Easter Program, 04/10/16

V. Service/Fellowship Projects:

All students must attend/participate in Service/Fellowship Projects, (1/2) by December and the remaining (1/2) by May. Some of these are rather simple. Some will require a greater commitment of time and energy. Please remember Stewardship involves TIME, TREASURE, & TALENT.
