Approval Required: Applications must be approved by the Steering Committee.

Elective choices will be determined by the date on which the application with payment is received.

Deadline: Deadline for registration is Friday, June 2, 2017. Registration will automatically be cut off if maximum enrollment is reached before that date.

Cost: The registration is \$125 for the first child, \$100 for each additional child in a family. **A check for full payment must accompany the registration application.** Make your checks payable to "St. Mark's Lutheran Church" with "Summer Music Camp" on the memo line. Early Registration: \$25.00 discount if payment is received by May 15th.

Scholarships may be available for families who need financial assistance. Please call Pastor Chuck if you need any info regarding scholarships.
