Cost: The registration is \$130 for the first child, \$105 for each additional child in a family. **A check for full payment must accompany the registration application.** Make your checks payable to "St. Mark's Lutheran Church" with "Summer Music Camp" on the memo line.

Early Registration: \$25.00 discount if payment is received by May 17th. Scholarships may be available for families who need financial assistance. Please call The Church Office if you need any info regarding scholarships.
