DID YOU KNOW?

This year marks the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther's treatise entitled The Freedom of a Christian. In it Luther writes "Christian(s).....do not live in themselves but in Christ and their neighbor, or else they are not Christian." He goes on to write "They live in Christ through faith and in the neighbor through love." In this treatise, Luther describes a "happy exchange" in that Jesus frees us from sin and, in turn, we are now free to serve our neighbors, whoever they may be. This treatise, written so many years ago, and still so relevant to today.
