LIFE LINE SCREENING

Life Line Screening is returning to St. Mark's on July 21st. They offer five preventive health screenings. You can choose just one or all of them.

They use ultra-sound screening to test for carotid artery plaque build-up, abdominal aneurysm risk, and osteoporosis risk assessment.

A quick, easy EKG with electrodes placed on arms and legs screens for irregular heartbeat. They also offer peripheral arterial disease screening.

There are flyers in the narthex explaining the services they provide. It also includes information on registering for the tests.
